



The ODP Interregional Showcase and Mike Rose Soccer Complex are keeping an on-going eye on the weather leading up to and during the event.

Currently, the event and games are **ON** as scheduled. Please plan accordingly.

Here are some recommendations and allowances for players to consider in preparation for participation:

- Plan on wearing additional layers of clothing during play, which can be added/removed as needed for player comfort throughout games.
- Game attire can include:
 - During play
 - Winter stocking caps (no hoods, no metal buttons or no strings dangling from hats allowed during play)
 - Face masks (COVID-19 PPE, gaiters, or thermal winter face coverings) are allowed as long as there is no hard plastic or strings hanging. **NO** scarves)
 - Gloves – sport gloves, wicking gloves or waterproof (no clasps or strings hanging)
 - Dress in layers as needed, recommended by US Soccer:
 - Inner Layer 1 – wicking layer (wool or polyester)
 - Middle Layer 2 – insulated layer (fleece or wool)
 - Outer layer 3- water and wind proof layer
 - Visible layer 4 – Jersey
 - “Under Armour” base layer style leggings under shorts
 - Off field and sideline warmth
 - Winter jackets
 - Blankets
 - Hand and feet warmers (NO electric or propane heaters permitted at facility)
- Work to ensure above clothing is dried appropriately between games for usage
- Carry extra cold weather gear, such as extra socks, gloves, hats, jacket, blankets, a change of clothes and a thermos of hot liquid in the car for after the games or to use as needed.
